

Medical School

Over the past month I have been involved in the Student over Profit Protest (against the ultra-commercialisation of campus life at the University of Malta) and am currently tackling the Medical School situation.

When discussing points to mention during the protest, I spoke to MMSA regarding the possibility of mentioning the Medical School and to jointly speak out about it. After the protest, I had a meeting with a representative from the Vassallo Group to further discuss the way forward concerning the medical school. This led to MHSA and MMSA teaming up to tackle such a problem.

After emailing the relevant authorities to request a meeting to discuss this urgent matter, we decided to release a statement to inform all students about the situation at hand and how we need their help to gather attention of relevant authorities to give us a date that is not 11 days away from our deadline. This deadline, which is the end of 2022, marks the fact that after this date, Vassallo group will have the authority to change the building into whatever they deem necessary, providing no guarantee that it will be a medical school.

After the statement was released, we contacted various media outlets to share our statement and, so far, we have been on the Times of Malta Newspaper, Lovin Malta, Newsbook and FreeHour. In the meantime, a video interview with FreeHour is being set up to help get more students to sign our petition that we created in order to reach more people with our statement.

The students who attended all seemed to have a good time and this event will surely be repeated next year!






World Profession Days


Blood Drive (2nd Sept)


Article #1
